

LEXINGTON CENTER CORPORATION ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE POLICY

The Lexington Center Corporation is the holder of the local and state convention center malt beverage and liquor licenses as provided by the Alcohol Beverage Control of the Commonwealth of Kentucky (ABC). The sale and service of all alcohol at Lexington Center (Rupp Arena, Convention Center, and Opera House) is regulated by the ABC. It is the responsibility of the Lexington Center Corporation to administer and abide by the following rules:

- No beer, wine, or distilled spirits of any kind may be brought on to Lexington Center property by an individual or outside service. This includes exhibitors in their respective trade show booths.
- Lexington Center staff must dispense all alcoholic beverages.
- Guests wishing to consume alcoholic beverages must provide valid form of identification and be 21 years of age or older.
- Lexington Center staff reserves the right to refuse alcohol service to any guest for any reason.
- Events seeking an alcohol sponsor must discuss this in advance with their Sales or Event Manager to ensure steps are taken to be in compliance with KRS statutes governing the sale of alcohol.

Alcohol sampling is not permitted in Kentucky at public events. If a client has an alcohol sponsor for a private event and wishes to distribute the product to their patrons, the current Kentucky Alcohol Beverage Control guidelines shall be followed. The alcohol must be purchased, received and dispensed by Lexington Center under the guidelines of our liquor licenses. The client must pay Lexington Center for both the alcohol purchase and service of the product.

If any alcoholic beverage is to be an item at an auction, then a special temporary distilled spirits and wine auction license must be applied for:

As stipulated by KRS Statute 423.036, the auction of any alcoholic beverage requires a temporary permit issued by Alcohol Beverage Control Board. The application process takes 30-45 days to complete. A permit must be presented in order for the item to be sold. For further details and the application process please contact the ABC Board at 859-258-3796.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE POLICY**

The sale, service or distribution of food or beverage products is an activity which is restricted to the Lexington Center Corporation and its designated representatives. This includes but is not limited to food/beverage items used in meetings, banquets, breaks and as traffic generators in trade shows (i.e. coffee, popcorn, sodas, bottled water, bar service, etc.)

Trade show vendors may request authorization to sample food items specific to their business by submitting the Food Sampling Authorization form to LCC prior to the event. Exposition sponsoring organizations and/or their exhibitors may distribute sample food and/or non-alcoholic beverage products only upon written authorization. All items are limited to sample size (beverage maximum 6oz container and 5oz of product; food items limited to “bite size”). Vendors requesting to sell food items must submit the Food Sale and Distribution Authorization form for LCC review; should approval be granted these vendors are subject to a \$50/day food vendor fee. All Sampling and / or Distribution Forms must be reviewed and approved no less than 14 days prior to the event.
